We have spent several thousand on searching and mailings this year and will have a lot more expense from now until the reunion. If you can donate please do. We are now a 501 (C) 19 Non Profit. We use a service (Same one that the VHPA uses) to search for names.

Also we need your help in phone calling. A lot of times we can find a phone number without a good address or email. If we can get 20 people to make 10-15 calls we will be able find a lot more people. We have lost at least 80 people that have died since their tour in Vietnam - and we need to work fast, if you know what I mean. Please volunteer. We need more help.

We have goals to compile the history of the unit in photos, stories and records. One way that makes it easier to find people is through copies of orders and rosters. Dig through your old records and send them to me. That is how we have built up our list to this point. This is very very important. There will be plenty of chances to volunteer for the projects that we have in mind.

Another important point. Please take a minute to update your mailing address to me. Email addresses change more rapidly than street addresses. Please share your phone numbers, addresses and Email. We do not publish this, sell it or allow it to be used for anything other than the association.

I guarantee you a good time at the reunion. Our goal is at least 100 members this year. If we start filling up our quota of hotel rooms we can get more but we need to know if you are planning on coming now.
